Explanations to select answers

- (C)** The word 'every' makes it a regular activity. Hence the verb is in present tense.
- (B)** It shows ability.
- (C)** Every sentence has to start with a capital letter and shall end in full stop.
- (A)** Anything to be done 'before' something makes the action compulsory; hence 'must'. 'D' is not correct as it shows only a possibility and also begins with a capital letter.
- (D)** Only 'or' fits in correctly. Option 'C' would be incorrect as there is no supporting punctuation.
- (A)** 'One' is pronounced as 'won' with a 'wa', which is a consonant sound. So article 'a' is used.
- (C)** We use 'the' before all directions.
- (C)** It is a positive statement. Sang = did + sing. So the question tag is negative and starts with 'did'.
