**Explanations to select answers**

- 18. (C)** Often in colloquial English, the word 'to' gets added as in option 'D'. However, that is not grammatically correct in reported speech.
- 21. (B)** Option 'B' is correct. Option 'D' could go near but is not exactly antonymous.
- 23. (A)** 'rooves' is not the plural of 'roof' although it has similar spelling characteristics as the word 'leaf'.
- 25. (B)** shows the error. The word 'every' shows habitual action and hence compels one to use simple present of the main verb 'come' instead of the 'present continuous' used thereat.
- 26. (A)** shows the error. In 'wh' interrogative questions the supporting/auxiliary verb has to precede the subject. Hence, it would be 'should I', not 'I should', as there.
- 41. (B)** All pictures in common carry one principle, 'saving energy' of some kind.
