### Explanations to select answers

8. (B) (shall) is correct. When suffixed by 'please', this remains to be a simple interrogative statement rendering 'shall' as verb for the 2nd person singular, to be correct.
9. (C) 'should' indicates the necessity, 'replacement of the defective ones' in this case.
10. (D) 'Continuously' means happening for a period of time without interruption and 'continually' means repeating many times in an annoying manner. Hence 'D' is correct.
12. (B) is correct as in parallelism of the earlier two verbs 'read' and 'write'. And 'to' has already appeared before 'read'.
14. (C) Option 'D', 'return' could have been correct if it would have been prefixed by 'to'; as then it would have completely described the "act of 'returning'".
18. (B) We always find a solution 'for' something when using formal English. That is the preposition that goes with it, as it means 'to show express purpose or cause'.
